Gorleston F.C.

A brief history

Gorleston Football Club is considered to have been formed in 1884 but it wasn't until 1905, following a merger with Gorleston St Andrews FC, that a Reserves side was created, initially called St Andrews FC.

St Andrews first trophy was in 1908, winning the Yarmouth & District League 2nd Division. At the end of that season, Gorleston successfully applied for senior club status and St Andrews became known as Gorleston Reserves.

The Reserves won the North Suffolk League in 1908/09, Yarmouth Borough League Division One in 1910/11 and in 1931, the Norfolk Junior Cup for the first time.

The Wiltshire Cup was won in 1933, the East Anglian League in 1953 and the Anglian Combination Reserve Cup in 1969. A second Junior Cup win came in 1973 and the third in 1978.

In 1976/77, the Reserves won the Anglian Combination Division Two, winning it again in 1980/81 followed by the Anglian Combination Division One title in 1982/83 and again in 2000/01.

In 2005, a club Extraordinary General Meeting held on 16th December, decided, in preference to the First Team dropping out of their league, the Greens would scrap the Reserve team due to severe financial restraints.

The Reserves were reformed for the start of the 2007/08 season, playing in Anglian

Combination Division 6 before switching to the Eastern Counties Reserve League. The Reserve League North was won in 2011/12, along with the Chell Trophy.

In 2015/16, the Reserves re-joined the Anglian Combination League, going into Division 5 South, finishing champions and not losing en route. also winning the CS Morley Cup.

2016/17 saw the Reserves win Anglian Combination Division 4 and retain the CS Morley Cup. Anglian Combination Division 3 was won in 2017/18.

The Reserves made it four titles in a row in 2018/19, winning Anglian Comb Division 2, and gaining promotion to Division 1, also winning the Norfolk Junior Cup again.

After the Covid seasons, in 2022/23, the Reserves finished runners up in Division 1 and were promoted to the Anglian Comb Premier Division and senior football.

2023/24 saw Gorleston Reserves settle at The Nest where they won the Anglian Combination Premier Division to gain promotion into the Thurlow Nunn First Division.

Swaffham Town Club History

OUR PROUD 130 YEAR HISTORY (1892-2022)

The club itself was founded in 1892 and had a rather successful start getting to the final of the Norfolk Junior Cup two years later, the club continued through the years until its next highpoint in 1951-1952 where the Junior Cup home was bought home after winning it for two consecutive years, capping off the historical era of the club on a high.

The modern era of the club as we know it today started back in 1959 where club legends such as Bob Tuttle, Albert Hudson and Gurney Titmarsh amongst others, purchased the land on behalf of the club for as little as £250.00. Swaffham Town Football Club has been built and is continued to be looked after by dedicated local family volunteers, who live in the town and surrounding villages and it's safe to say we are proud of the legacy left behind of those still with us and those who unfortunately are not.

The original club house itself was located further up the pitch and was a relatively small building containing changing rooms and a tiny area to have a tea after the match. I'm told one of the standout memories of the old club house was the communal team bath that took the whole game to fill up. As time passed the club grew and it was decided to relocate the clubhouse to its position today, at the bottom of the infamous slope. This

took place after the late 60's and into the 70's and the works were again completed by local families such as the Leadbetters, Tuttle's, Palmer's, Hudson's, Ward's and the Titmarsh's and it's safe to say that they did a fantastic job.

The club progressed throughout the coming years and became the stable senior outfit it is today, drifting between the two divisions in the then Jewson league and the Thurlow Nunn league as it is known to date under managers such as Lucian hodkinson and Paul hunt. Throughout those years' memorable characters such as, Jock, Stuart Seales, David Leadbetter, Mark Blockwell and David Spalding have put on the famous black and white stripes.

The highest level the club has ever reached is step 5 in the English footballing pyramid.

Personally I see the history of the club being in two phases as mentioned above, but I believe we are now entering a third phase. The club is currently going through a modernisation in attempt to align ourselves with those up to speed within leagues above, there really is an ambition to succeed amongst the playing staff and the committee alike and we welcome anyone who wants to get involved with taking, in my opinion, a proper local football club forward.
